Firmware updates are put out periodically by Epson to correct problems or issues that have arisen since the printer's general release. It is important to upgrade your firmware often. Doing so will increase the overall functionality of your system. The latest firmware upgrade as of June 2007- **SNO1475 (7800) & SWO1475 (9800)**.

How do I check what version firmware I have?

1. Press the "Menu" button.
2. Arrow down until "Printer Status" is displayed.
3. Press the "Menu" button.
4. Arrow down until "Version" is displayed.
5. Press the "Menu" button. This will give you the current version firmware loaded on your printer.
6. To get back to Ready, press the "Pause" (trash can) button.

**How do I update my firmware?**

1. The Epson Remote Panel Utility is used to update the firmware. Instructions for using the utility are included in the application.
2. If you did not install the Epson Remote Panel Utility during the driver installation process, you can access it and the newest firmware version by visiting us at [www.fujihuntusa.com/html/dpi\\_support\\_downloads.asp](http://www.fujihuntusa.com/html/dpi_support_downloads.asp). Just choose go to the bottom of the page and choose which printer you have. We'll link you to the correct section of the Epson site

**What enhancements are included in this firmware upgrade?**

1. An error message is displayed when there are media mismatch settings between the printer and the printer software.

So for peak performance keep your firmware up to date. But don't worry if you haven't upgraded for a while. All firmware upgrades include all previous firmware enhancements.

**Getting Into the Scrapbooking Craze**

Why not provide a total package price in increments of say 10, 15 or 20 pagers that includes the scanning, printing and binding of the duplicate scrap book. For binding you can use standard office document binding systems or something like the adhesive systems offered from Unibind ([www.unibind.com](http://www.unibind.com)).

Your customers will no longer have to deal with disappointed relatives. And you gain a whole new revenue stream.
